There are four levels and it is a requirement that all levels are completed before moving to the next level. These training courses come under the auspices of the Australian National Council of Orff Schulwerk.

There are six days, with six sessions of 60 min every day, which covers the following aspects of the teaching process: creative movement and dance, orchestration, technique and improvisation, recorder, vocal and pedagogy. Every day runs from 9.00 am – 5.00 pm, and the FULL 36 hour attendance is required to attain accreditation.
